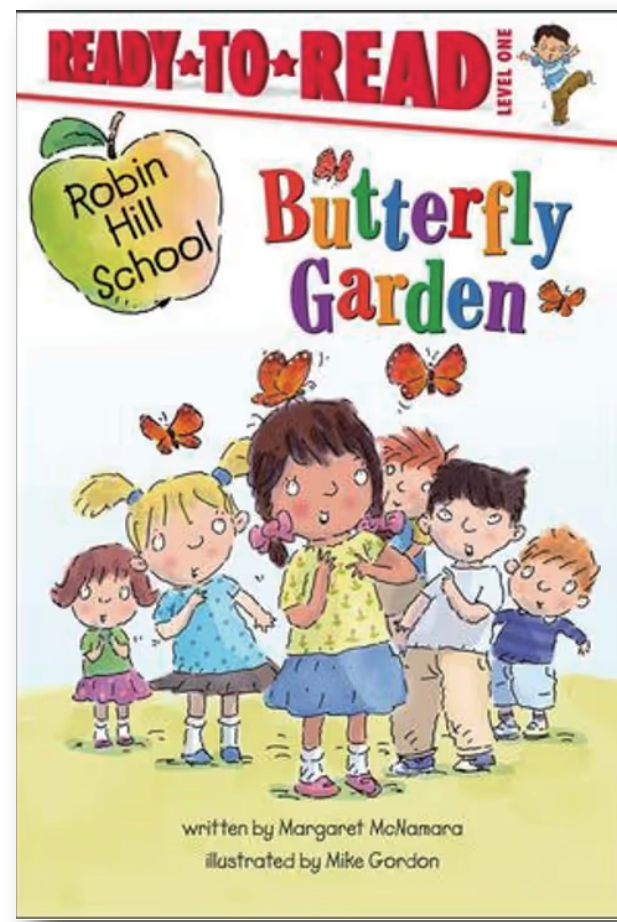


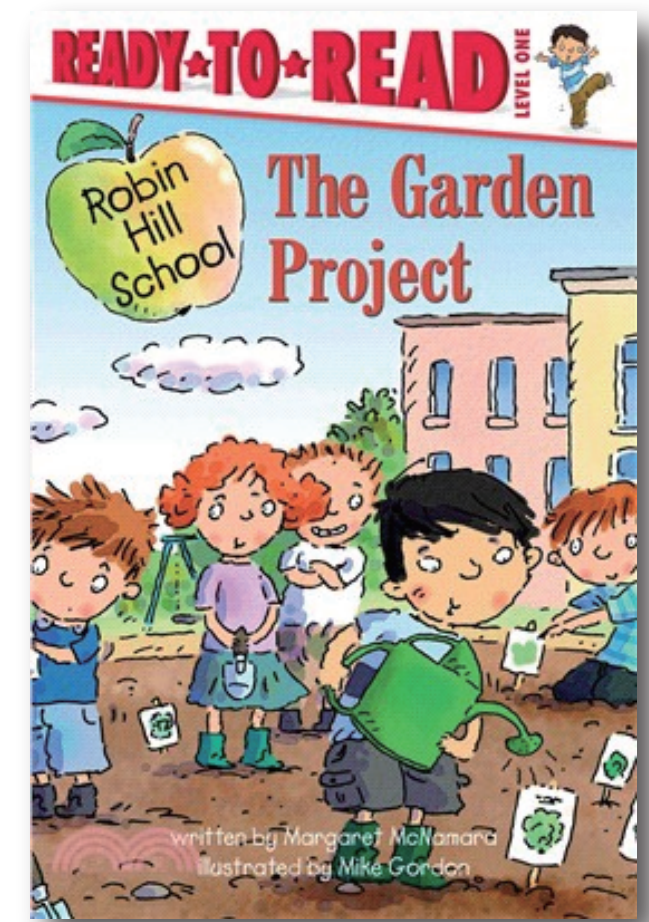
Olivia Plants a Garden

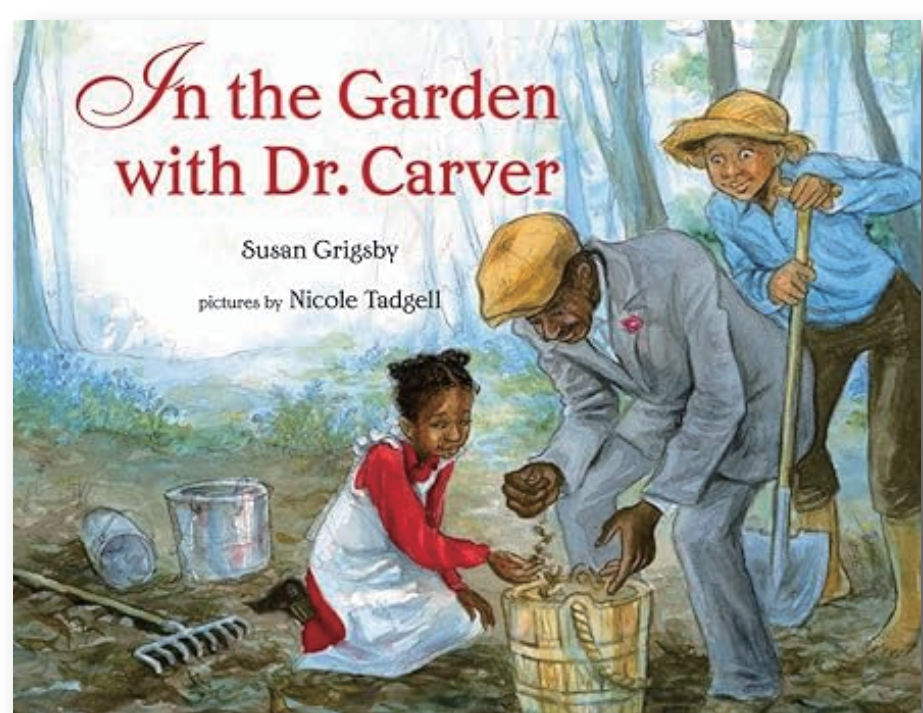
Butterfly Garden

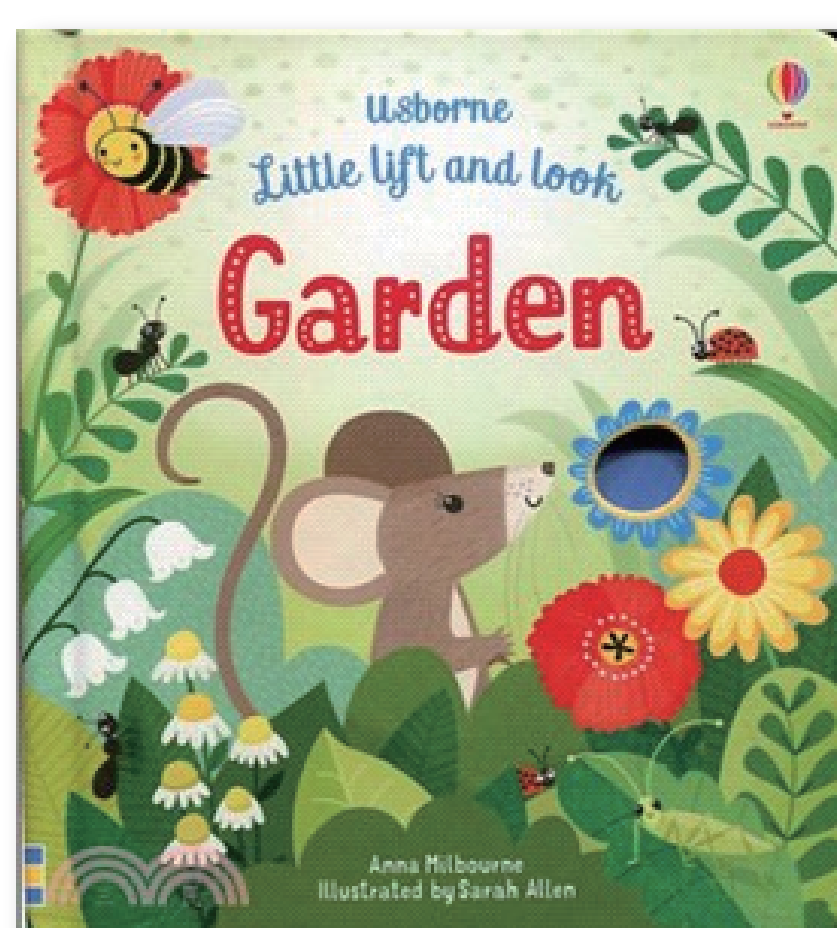
The Garden Project

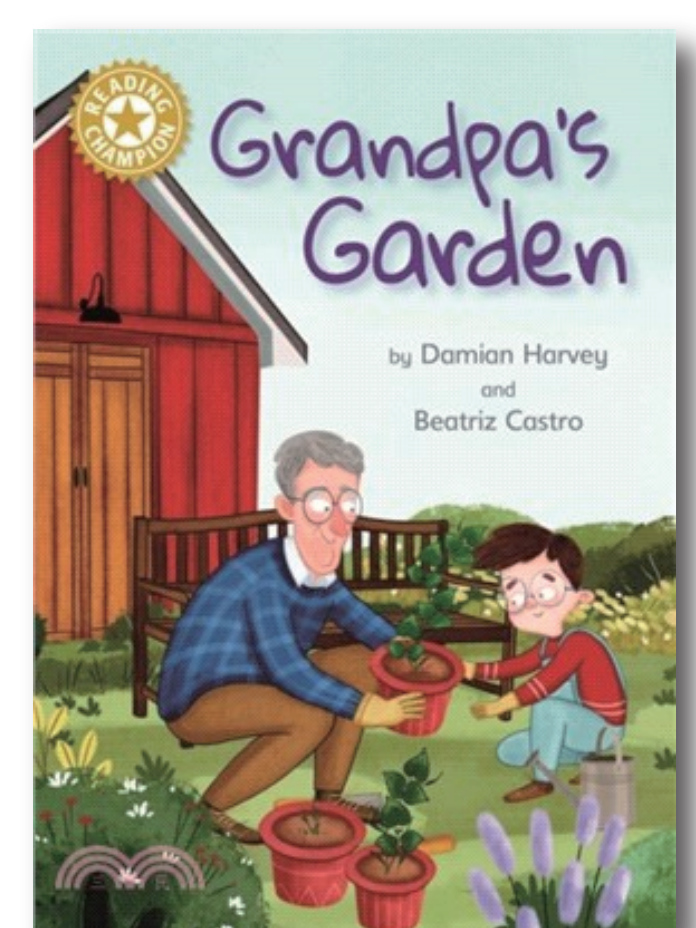
In the Garden With Dr. Carver
