

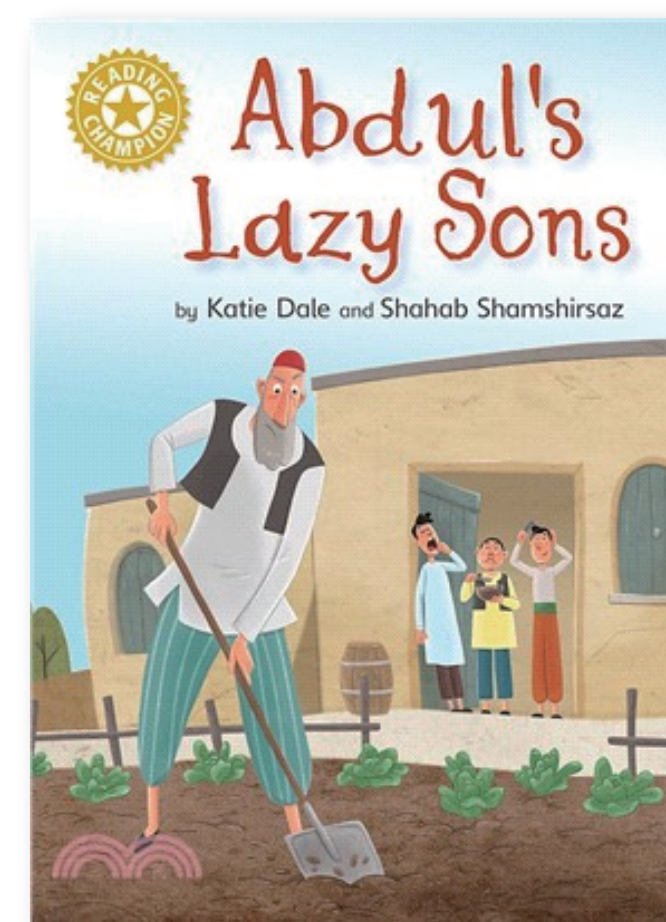
Ben Plants a Butterfly Garden

Gertie loves living on a farm but she wants to be useful like the other animals. But herding sheep and making Farmer Daisy's dinner is much harder than it looks.



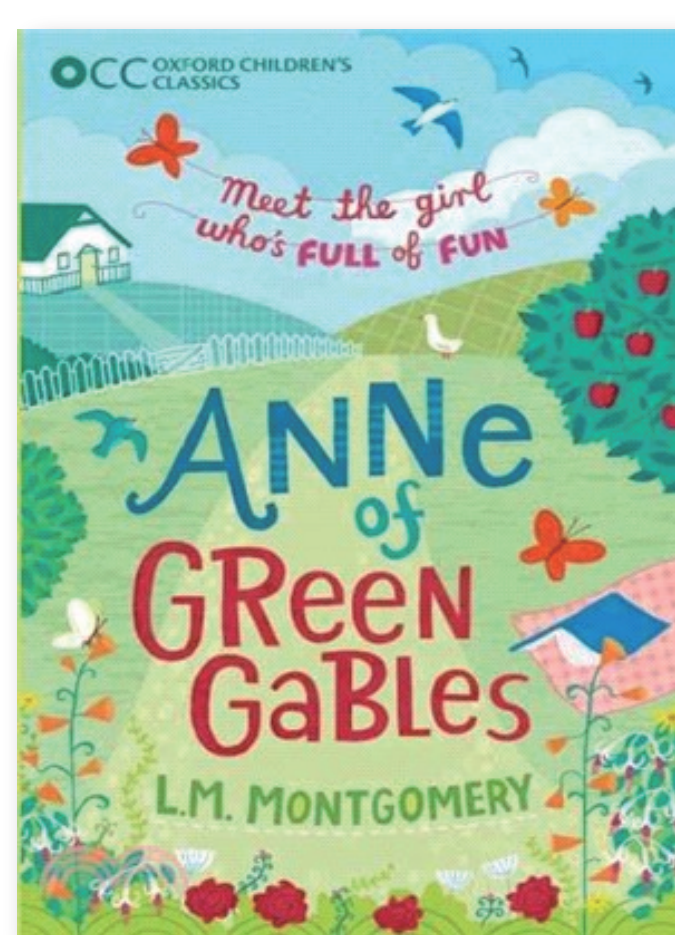
Abdul's Lazy Sons

Abdul works hard on the farm, but his sons never help. They are far too lazy! Then Abdul thinks of a clever trick to make them work very hard indeed ...



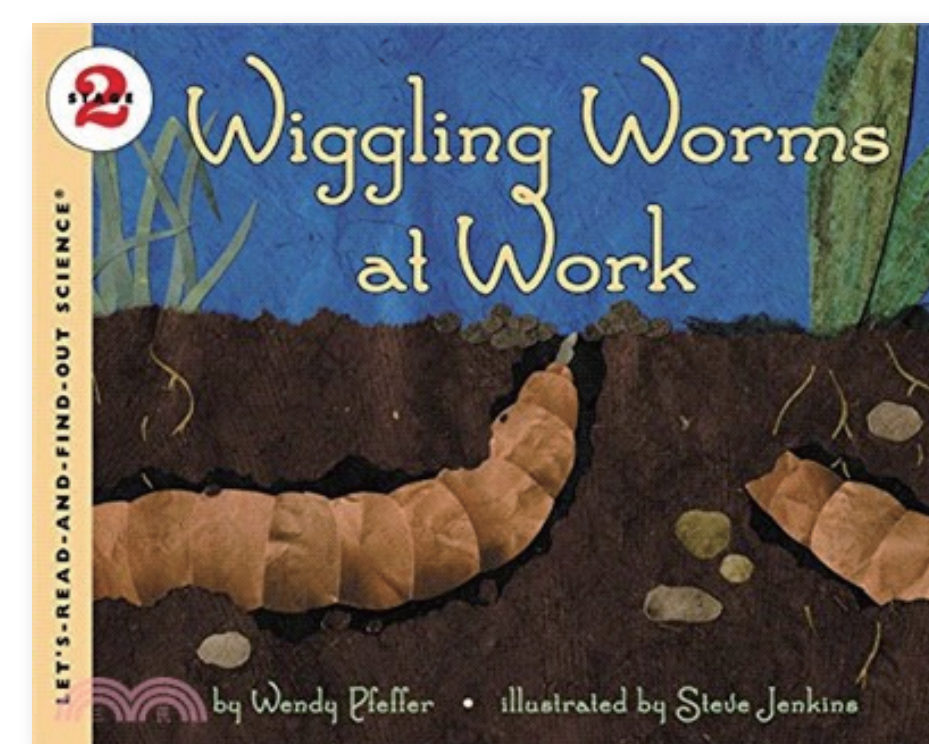
Flat Stanley and the Missing Pumpkins
