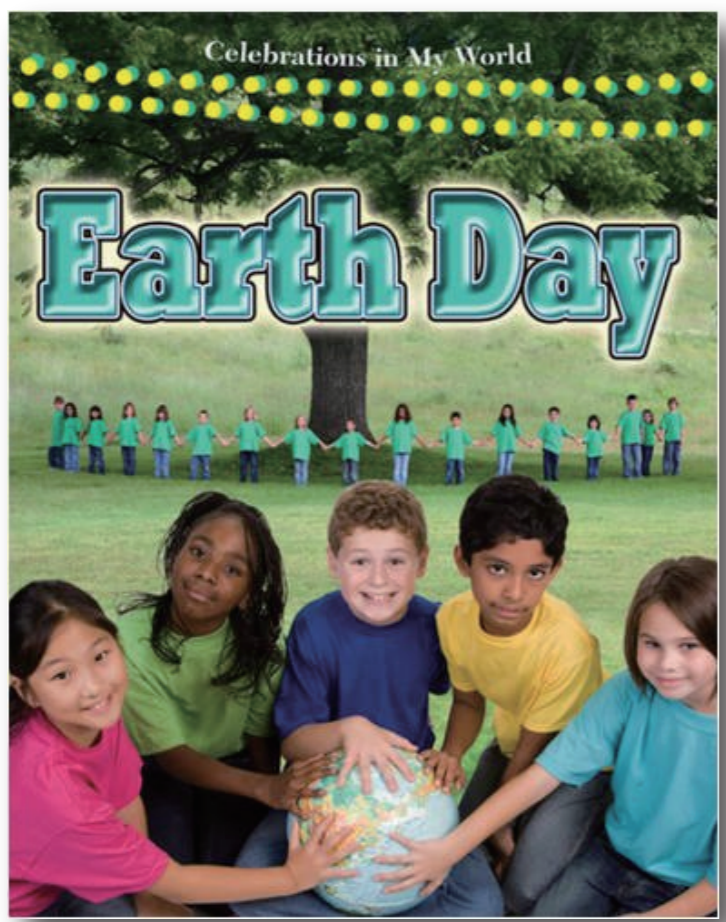

我們的節氣

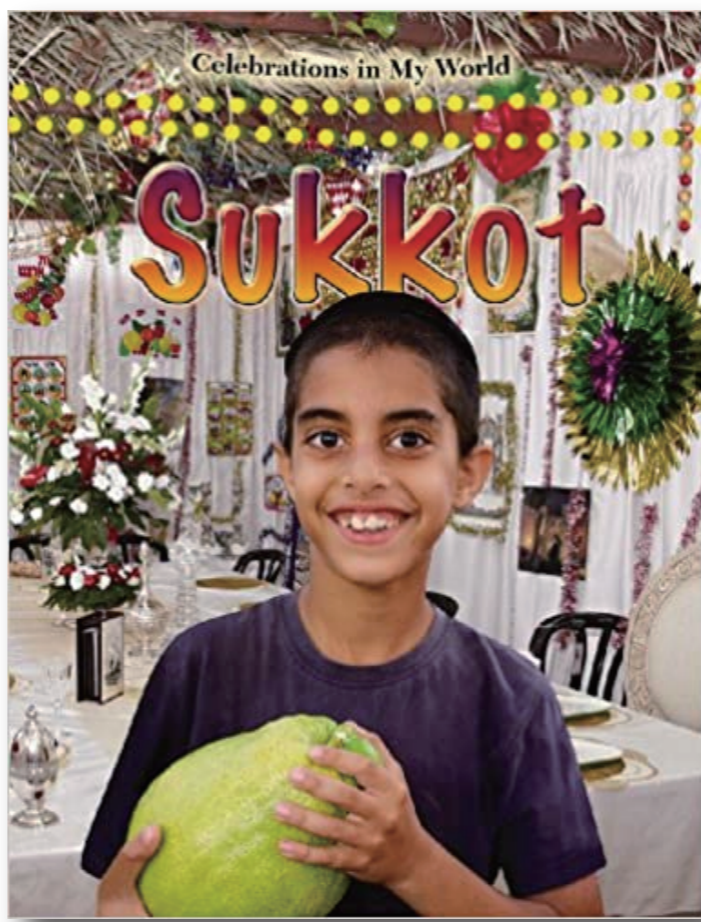

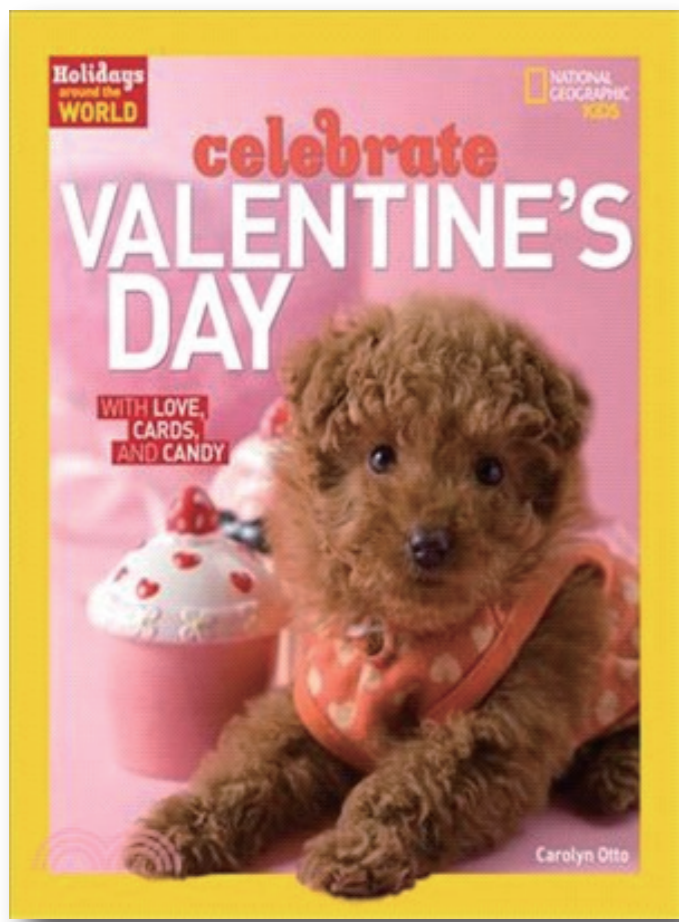
Introduces the holiday of Thanksgiving and why it is celebrated in the United States, including its significance, origins, and traditions.

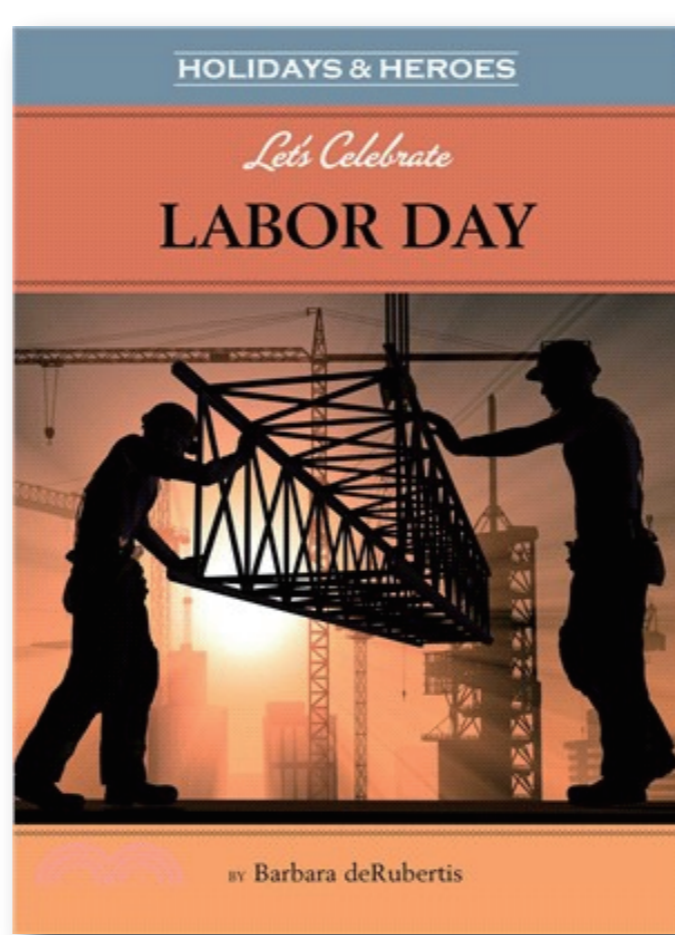

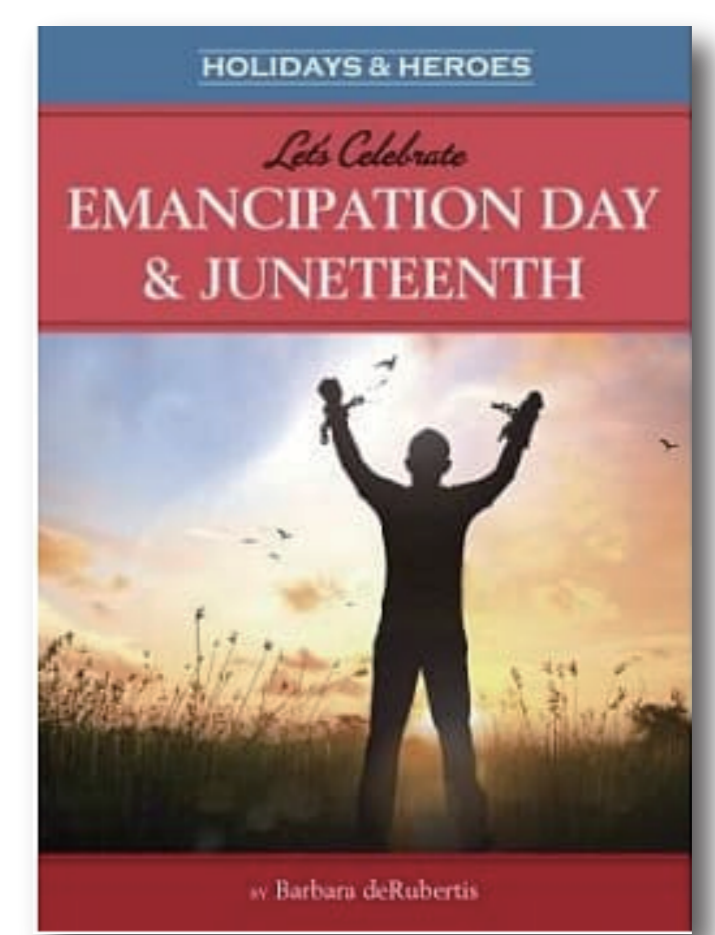
