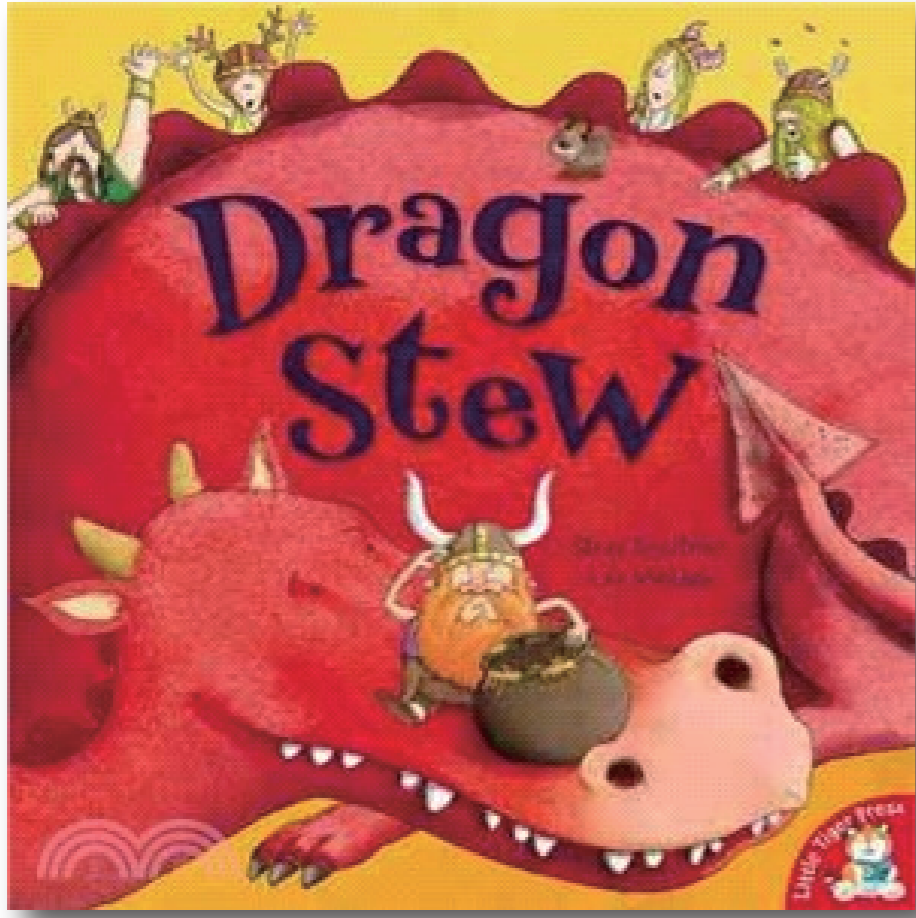


# Year of the DRAGON

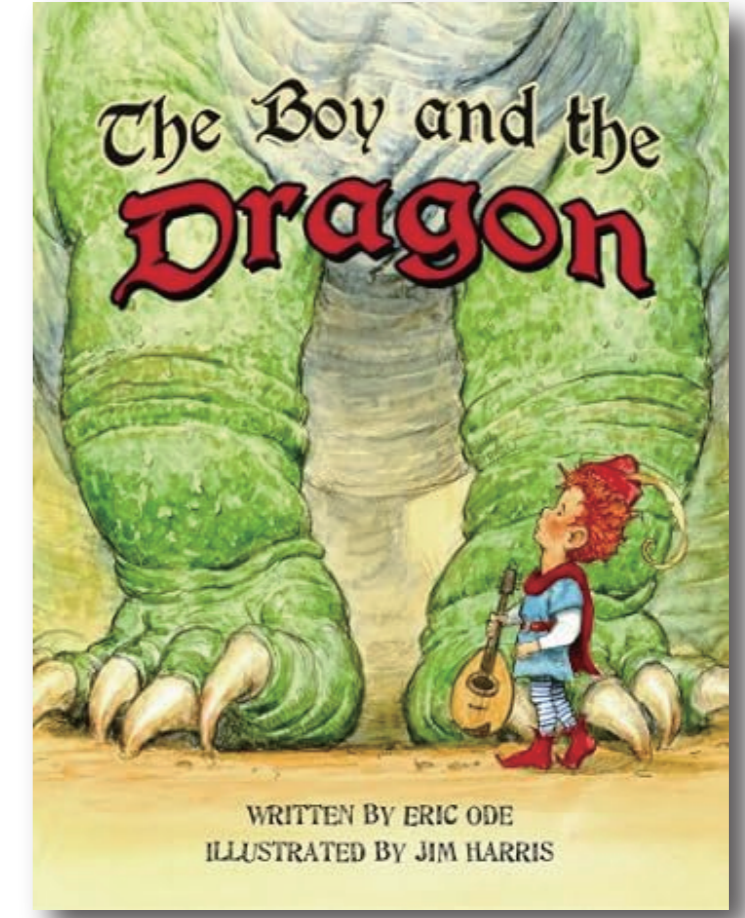

A case of mistaken identity allows two sworn enemies— a young dragon and knight— to become friends. But what will they do when they discover the truth?

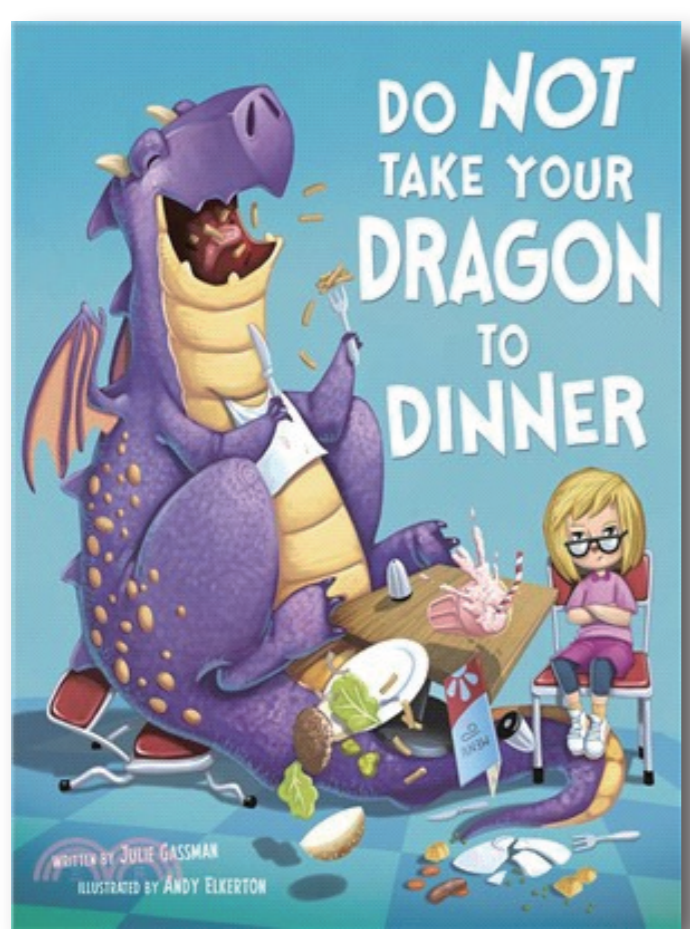

This is the tale of three knights and a boy who travel east in search of a horrid and hideous beast. Is it the boy who finally succeeds in outwitting this dragon?

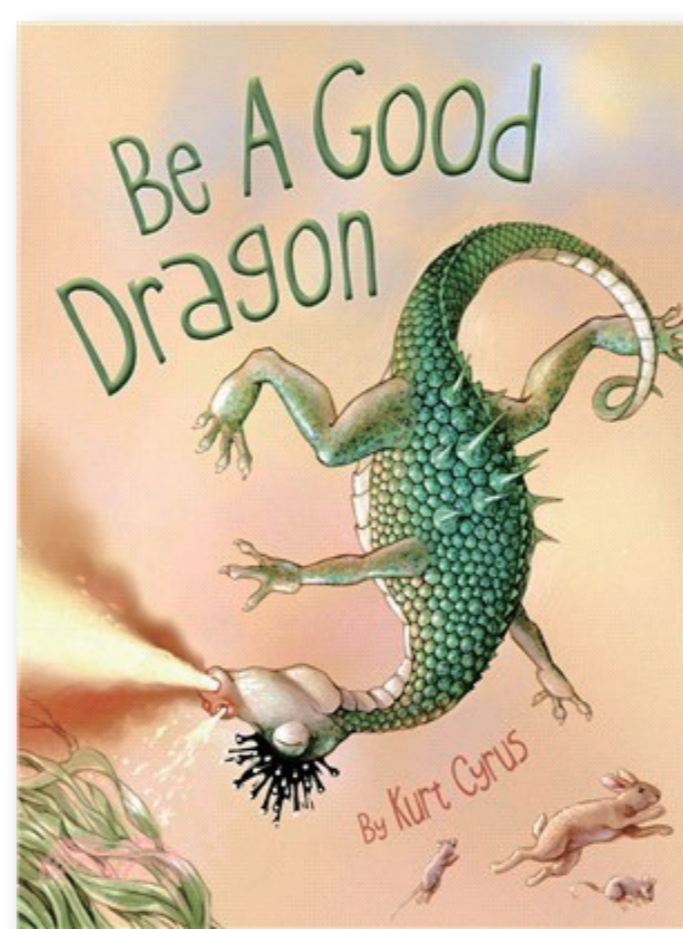
